INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE 12<sup>th</sup> SOUTH ASIAN BODYBUILDING & PHYSIQUE SPORTS CHAMPIONSHIPS IN KATHMANDU, NEPAL

# 1. Date - Venue and Official Hotels.

DATES: 18-21 July, 2019-Kathmandu, Nepal

VENUE OF COMPETITION: (Pre-Judging) & (Finals) – Nepal Academy Hall, Kathmandu

HOTELS: Royal Singhi Hotel, Durbar Marg, Kathmandu.

# 2. Registration Fees.

US\$120.00 per person per day, the total amount is US\$360 for each person for the duration of 3 nights to stay in a twin bedded sharing room. This fee includes hotel accommodation, 3 meals per day, shuttle from airport to hotel vis-a-vis and to competition venue, farewell party, sight-seeing etc.

## 3. Payments

No Credit Cards. Only Cash payment in US Dollars and Nepalese currency will be accepted for registration fees and for other expenses including at shopping centres.

# 4. Entry Rules

- a) Country with less than three (3) competitors, only one (1) official will be allowed.
- b) Country with three (3) or more competitors, two officials will be allowed Exceeding number of officials as per 4 (a) and 4 (b) shall be considered as "supporters or extra delegates".

# 5. Extra Delegates, Officials and Supporters

All extra delegates, officials and supporters will bear their own expenses.

# 6. Exemptions

ABBF Executive Committee Members and SABBF Executive and Standing Committee members are exempted from paying the Registration fees.

# 7. Judge

Kindly nominate the name of your judge before 15th June, 2019 to the Chairman of the Judges Committee; Ms. Christina Y. Kam at email <a href="mailto:abbf.adm@hotmail.com">abbf.adm@hotmail.com</a> Last minute submission will be rejected. All judges should use a grey suit with the official logo of ABBF/WBPF and female judges with dark grey blazer with grey skirt or dress pants.

- a) One judge per country will be allowed on gratis (no registration to pay), however, the judge must share a triple or twin bed room with other judges/officials;
- b) If more than 1 (one) judge is nominated, he or she has to pay registration fee, however, a country will be limited to enter 1 (one) extra judges to enjoy this privilege on triple or twin sharing room. Max. Number of Judges should be (2) two only. All other extra judges will have to pay the supporters fee in full.

# 7. Early Arrivals and Late Departures

Any team or officials arriving early or departing late are required to pay for the extra days.

# 8. Entry Forms

- b) Final Entry Forms must be submitted on or before 15th June, 2019.

# 10. National Anthem/National Flag

- a) You must bring along two (2) national flags of your country. The flags must be manufactured of dense silk and must measure no more than 2.5 meters x 1.4 meters
- b) You must also provide your National Anthem (shortened version) on CD or pen drive. Video Tape no acceptable.

# 11. Posing Music

Posing music must be on CD or pen drive only and produced with good quality. The music must be at the start of the CD or pen drive and must be the only music on the CD or pen drive. Each competitor must affix his name on the CD or pen drive for easy identification. MAKE SURE THAT VULGAR WORDS ARE NOT CONTAINED IN THE LYRICS.

# 12. Airport

The arrival airport is the TribhuvanInternational Airport, Kathmandu. The Organising Committee will pick you up at this airport on arrival and transport you to the Official Hotel. It is very important that every National Federation or Official provide to the Organising Committee complete arrival details of its team, including the number of people in its delegation.

# 16. Photos for ID Cards

All participants ( DELEGATES, COMPETITORS, EXECUTIVE MEMBERS AND SUPPORTERS), must send one recent passport size photo as an attachment together with the Entry Forms or by e-mail attachment with all their particulars clearly stated. This is for issuance of Identity Cards. FAILING TO PROVIDE the photo, you will be charged US\$20.- for the I.D. photo if taken in Kathmandu.

## **17. VISA**

Please check with your travel agents or Ministry of Tourism if Visa is required to enter into Kathmandu Airport. If you need assistance from the host country, please let them know two months (60 days) in advance. LAST MINUTE REQUEST WILL BE IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE ORGANISER TO ASSIST YOU.Indian Citizen does not require a visa and have to produce valid ID (Passport/Ration Card). Visa on arrival can be obtained but is advisable to get visa from Nepalese Embassy to avoid delays at Airport.

# **Top Attractions in Kathmandu**

## 1. Boudhanath Stupa



Bouddhanath stupa is the most liked sightseeing place in Kathmandu. Visitors are required to pay NRs. 250(Foreign Nationals) NRs. 50 (SAARC Nationals) NRs. 250 (Chinese) per person (Below 10 years free) as entrance fees to the Bouddhanath. A lot of Tibetan people reside around the Stupa. And it is very famous and holy place specially of Buddhists People. It is one of the most popular world heritage site of Nepal. Breakfree Adventures offer Bouddhanath Private Sightseeing Day Tours.

# 2. Swayambhunath Temple



Swayambhunath is a glorious ancient religious architecture, located in the middle of Kathmandu city. It is center of faith of both Buddhist and Hindus.

# 3. Kumari, The Living Goddess of Nepal



The word Kumari originates from the Sanskrit word *Kaumarya*. It means virgin referring to the culture of worshiping the virgins. Kumari is also the childhood name of Lord Durga, one of the main Gods of the Hindu religion. Nepalese believe Kumari as the manifestation of Lord Durga (TalejuBhawani) in the body of a pure prepubescent girl. She is worth worshiping until she suffers some kind of injury or illness or until her first periods. History records that the tradition of worshiping a virgin girl started during the regime of the last Malla king Jaya Prakash Malla. He had a dream where Goddess Taleju ordered him to select and worship a virgin girl from a Shakya or Bajracharya family as the manifestation of herself. Hence, he ordered his men the task of building KumariBahal (home of Kumari in the Basantpur area) and also started the festival of drawing the chariot of goddess Kumari along with the chariots of Lord Ganesh and Bhairav.

## 4. PashupathNath Temple



The Pashupatinath Temple is a famous and sacred Hindu temple complex that is located on the banks of the Bagmati River, approximately 5 kilometres north-east of Kathmandu in the eastern part of Kathmandu Valley,

the capital of Nepal. The temple serves as the seat of Nepal's national deity, Lord Pashupatinath. This temple complex was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage Sites's list in 1979.

#### 5. Chandragiri Hills



Chandragiri Hills Ltd is a Hospitality Company which operates cable car, restaurants & bar,conference center and branded shops in ThankotKathmandu,with its upcoming attraction being amusement park, boutique resort, paragliding,, zip flying and many more.

#### 6. Garden of Dreams




The Garden of Dreams, a neo classical historical garden, is situated in the midst of Kathmandu city, Nepal. The Garden's design has much in common with formal European gardens: paved perimeter paths, punctuated by pavilions, trellises, and various planting areas, surrounded by a sunken flower garden with a large pond at its center. It is an architectural landscape that encourages the visitor to stroll around and discover the Garden's treasures from many different vantage points.

#### 7. Thamel Free Street - No Vehicle Area



Thamel is the heart of Kathmandu, the capital city of Nepal. It's well known as a tourist hub and is one of the most popular commercial centers of Nepal with various shops, vendors, restaurants and quality hotels serving much different cuisine.

## 8. Durbar Square (Patan)



The ancient royal palace of Patan faces on to magnificent Durbar Sq. This concentrated mass of temples is perhaps the most visually stunning display of Newari architecture to be seen in Nepal. Temple construction in the square went into overdrive during the Malla period (14th to 18th centuries), particularly during the reign of King SiddhinarsinghMalla (1619–60). It's well worth at least a half-day trip from Kathmandu.

### 9. Durbar Square (Bhaktapur)



The ancient city Bhaktapur lies on the Eastern part of Kathmandu valley which is also known as Bhadgaon or Khwopa, Bhaktapur. It is regarded as the abode of traditional Nepali culture, custom and unique arts of wooden and potteries. The historical monument on around signifies medieval age culture and tradition of Nepal and this old city is inhabited by indigenous Newari people in large group. The main attractive monuments are Nyatapola Temple, statue of King BhupatindraMalla, Peacock Window, Golden Gate and fifty-five windowed palace of Bhaktapur Durbar Square.

#### 10. Kopan Monastery



Kopan Monastery is a center for Buddhist study, meditation, retreat., and practice. It is nestled in the foothills of the Himalayas, in the Kathmandu valley in Nepal.It was established in the late 1960's by Lama Yeshe and Lama Zopa Rinpoche as a home for monks and nuns from the Himalayan area and foreigners wishing to receive teachings. This is still the mission of Kopan monastery today: preserve and transmit the Tibetan Buddhist tradition as the path to ultimate happiness and freedom from suffering to all.
