- Each athlete must bring his/her passport and posing music to the weigh-in and registration, failing which the athlete weigh-in will not be processed.
- No G-string bikinis are allowed. An athlete must comply with specification sheet attached and they must produce their bikinis for verification and approval for the pre-judging and finals at the weigh-in area. The bikinis will be stamped with a marker as an approval by the Judges Committee.
- During the weigh-in, all female athletes should be properly dressed. NO PYJAMAS OR NIGHT GOWNS are allowed. This is to protect the image of our sport in the event press or VIPs were to be present during the weigh-in, it will put our sport in an awkward position. Please use track suits or a decent dress/jean.
- At the parade of the nations, if you were to allocate female athletes, she should also appear in a track suit and not in a bikini.
- All female athletes are to be reminded that they are participating in a sporting event and not in entertainment venues like night clubs, therefore, we should ask the women to change their behaviour when they come on to the stage in the "walk-in" wiggling their rear ends or looking back into the audience when they stand in the quarter turn facing the back of the stage and stretching out their butt and winking at the judges and the audience. This is not a sports presentation and it will be seen as sexual harassment to the public.

All media accreditation, except local media, shall be controlled by the ABBF. All persons wishing to obtain media accreditation for this event must register with the ABBF by completing and signing Media Accreditation the ABBF Media Accreditation Form. The form must be submitted to the ABBF by email at abbf.adm@hotmail.com and abbf.secretary@yahoo.com All athletes competing at ABBF Championships must be members in good standing of their National Federations. Any athlete who arrives without a delegate must carry on the official letter of Athletes without Delegates Authorization of Participation from his/her National Federation, failing which the athletes will not be eligible to participate. Deadlines are set to assist the Organizer with arranging accommodations, meal, onsite transportation and other Championships activities. A failure to respect these deadlines is a breach of the ABBF rules. If a National Federation fails to respect Failure to Honour Final the deadline written on the Final Entry Form, each "Official Entry Form Deadline. Participant" from that federation will be required to pay all of his or her own expenses, including accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the Pre-judging, Finals and Farewell Banquet. Misrepresentation is a serious breach of the ABBF Code of Ethics and occurs when an "Official" of a National Federation deliberately misrepresents the number of Athletes and Delegates so as to obtain free-of-charge accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the prejudging. Finals and farewell Misrepresentation Banquet, and other amenities at the expense of the organizer. Part of this misrepresentation may be a false claim that a person is an Athlete only to have that so-called athlete fail to officially register as a competitor at the Weigh-I or, once having officially. Once officially registered, no Athlete ma withdraw from the competition, without the prior approval of the ABBF Judges Chairman, who has the right to verify the reason for the Medical Withdrawal withdrawal. Any National Federation that fails to seek the prior approval of the ABBF Judges Chairman before withdrawing an athlete shall, for that athlete's non-participation, is fined an amount equal to the Special Package Rate. National Federations officially All participating in the Attendance at the ABBF Championships must attend the Congress meeting, including National Federations with athletes and no delegates. In this case, Congress the athlete must attend and represent his country at the congress.

Maldives, officially the Republic of Maldives and also referred to as the Maldive Islands, is an island nation in the Indian Ocean consisting of a double chain of twenty-six atolls, orientated north-south, that lie about 700 kilometres (430 mi) south-west of Sri Lanka and 400 kilometres (250 mi) south-west of India.

The Maldives atolls are one of the world's most geographically dispersed and is the smallest Asian country in both population and land area. It is also the planet's lowest country. However, more than 80 per cent of the country's land is composed of coral islands that rise less than one metre above sea level. The reef is composed of coral debris and living coral. This acts as a natural barrier against the sea, forming lagoons.

Maldives Culture & Traditions

The Maldivian ethnic identity is a blend of the cultures reflecting the peoples who settled on the islands, reinforced by religion and language. The earliest settlers were probably from southern India and Sri Lanka. They are linguistically and ethnically related to the people in the Indian subcontinent. They are ethnically known as Dhivehis. The official and common language is Dhivehi.

After the long Buddhist period of Maldivian history, Muslim traders introduced Sunni Islam. Maldivians converted to Islam by the mid-12th century. Since the 12th century AD there were also influences from Arabia in the language and culture of the Maldives because of the conversion to Islam and its location as a crossroads in the central Indian Ocean. This was due to the long trading history between the Far East and the Middle East.

Maldivian Cuisine

Traditional Maldivian cuisine is based on the following three main items and their derivatives: The coconut is used in the grated form, squeezed to obtain coconut milk, or as coconut oil in dishes that are deep-fried. The coconut milk is an essential ingredient in many Maldivian curries and other dishes. The favourite fish is skipjack tuna, either dried or fresh. Dry processed tuna is mainly used to make short eats called gulha, kavaabu, bajiyaa (the local version of the Indian samosa), and fatafolhi. Starchy items like rice, which is eaten boiled or ground into flour, tubers like taro (ala), sweet potato (kattala), or tapioca (dandialuvi), as well as fruits like breadfruit (bambukeyo) or screwpine (kashikeyo).
