


HOST CITY

Pune, formerly spelled Poona (1857-1978), is the second largest city in the Indian state of Maharashtra after Mumbai. It is the ninth most populous city in the country with an estimated population of 3.13 million. Along with its industrial twin Pimpri-Chinchwad as well as the three cantonment areas of Pune, Khadki and Dehu Road, Pune forms the urban core of the eponymous Pune Metropolitan Region. According to the 2011 census, the urban area has a combined population of 5.05 million while the population of the metropolitan region is estimated at 7.27 million. Situated 560 metres (1,837 feet) above sea level on the Deccan plateau on the right bank of the Mutha river, Pune is also the administrative headquarters of its namesake district. In the 18th century, the city was the seat of the Peshwas, the prime ministers of the Maratha Empire and hence, one of the most important political centers on the Indian subcontinent.

Considered to be the cultural capital of Maharashtra, Pune is known as "Oxford of the East" due to the presence of several well-known educational institutions. The city has emerged as a major educational hub in recent decades, with nearly half of the total international students in the country studying in Pune. Since the 1950s and 1960s, Pune has had a traditional old-economic base as most of the old industries continue to grow. The city is known for its manufacturing and automobile industries, as well as for research institutes of information technology (IT), education, management and training, which attracts students and professionals from India, Southeast Asia, the Middle East and Africa. [citation needed] Several colleges in Pune have student-exchange programs with colleges in Europe. The game of Badminton was developed in Pune and the game's earlier name was Poona.
























WAY TO HOTEL From Mumbai & Pune Airport

Additional days or meals must be paid individually and has to be requested in advance. Room reservation must be sent through the office of your National Federation and should be copied to the ABBF Secretariat(abbf.secretary@yahoo.com) and the General Secretary (ibbf_mumbai@yahoo.in) well before the above mentioned deadline, which is 02nd Aug 2018 Only these reservations will be accepted and registered.

EXTRA OFFICIALS

Any judges, coaches or trainers who are not official participants (Athletes or Delegates) will be responsible for all of their own expenses.

Only those Athletes, Judge's, Official's, Delegates, Suppoters whos names are recomended by their respective National Federation will only be allowed to participate in the championship.

Any Athlete or official without the consent of their respective National Federation will not be allowed to participate in the said championship.

NO EXCEPTION WILL BE MADE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

A hotel security deposit of Min 100 US Dollars & Max 500 US Dollars per team is required upon check-in for incidental and personal expenses that may arise (telephone, minibar, laundry, room services etc.) The unused portion of this deposit will be refunded at check-out. In order to facilitate matters, the Chief Delegate or Team Manager will be asked to provide a Credit Card or Cash to cover the deposit for the entire team. This individual will be fully responsible for all expenses incurred by any members of his or her team.

REGISTRATION FEES

OFFICIAL AND ATHLETES REGISTRATION FEES

The total amount is 720 USD for each person for the duration of 6 nights stay in a twin bedded sharing room. We have package price only.

This fee includes hotel accommodation, 3 meals per day, shuttle to and from airport to hotel and to competition venue and farewell party.

The price of the double rooms (720 USD/6 nights per person x 2 persons = 1440.00 USD).

Single room price 1000 USD/6 days. These prices are available for the officials and delegates as well.

ABBF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

ABBF Executive Committee members are exempted from paying the Registration Fees, including Patrons and Honorary Life Members. ABBF Executive Committee Members are allowed to be accompanied by their spouse only. Their accommodation, Meals, etc. are on gratis.

Standing Committee Members with the exception of the chairman & secretary of each sub committee may have to share a twin sharing room. If a sub committee member request a single room, he/she must pay the difference of 250.00 USD for a single room for the duration of 6 nights.

EXTRA DELEGATES, OFFICIALS AND SUPPORTERS

All extra delegates, extra officials, family and supporters are required to pay as follows for accommodation:

SINGLE ROOM : 1000 USD per person Cash payment

TWIN SHARING ROOM : 720 USD (6 nights twin bedded sharing room.)


The above charges include airport transfers, 3 meals and farewell party, 6 nights hotel accommodation, Invitee Pass for the Pre-judging and Finals.

EARLY ARRIVALS AND LATE DEPARTURES

Any team or officials arriving early or departing late are required to pay for the extra days per night for a

PAYMENTS

Only cash payments in USD-United States Dollars or Indian Rupees [One Dollar = 66.00 Rupees Approx.] will be accepted for Registration Fees.

You may use Credit Card payment in large departmental stores. It is to be noted by the Guests that Indian Malls/Departmental stores/Chemists are not having facility of accepting US Dollars. The Secretariat may arrange for the Currency Exchange depending on the availability.

The rate of exchange may differ at the time of Registration

WEIGH-IN AND REGISTRATION

Registration for athletes and Weigh-in will take place at the Hotel Orchid, on **03rd October**, **2018** @ **03:00PM**. It is the responsibility of the Chief Delegate or Team Manager to make sure that all athletes are on time for the Weigh-in and Registration. If an athlete is late for the Weigh-in and Registration, that athlete will be disqualified and will have to pay all of his own expenses.

JUDGES


In order to assist the ABBF Judges Committee in their selection of judges for this Championship, please forward your nomination for Judges from your National Federation as soon as possible but no later than 15th Aug 2018 Judges must possess an International/Continental recognized judges card and must produce to the Judges Committee at Pune. SECRETARIAT

The Organizing Committee will maintain a Secretariat at the Reception of the Hotel from 8.00 AM to 11.00 PM from 01st October – 08th October, 2018. You may obtain information and assistance from the Secretariat.

Kindly nominate the name of your judges in advance; last minute submission will be rejected. All judges should use a grey suit with the official logo of ABBF / WBPF and female judges with grey blazer with grey skirt or dress pants.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- Each athlete must bring his/her passport and posing music to the weigh-in and registration, failing which the athlete weigh-in will not be processed.
- No G-string bikinis are allowed. An athlete must comply with specification sheet attached and they must produce their bikinis for verification and approval for the pre-judging and finals at the weigh-in area. The bikinis will be stamped with a marker as an approval by the Judges Committee.
- During the weigh-in, all female athletes should be properly dressed. NO PYJAMAS OR NIGHT GOWNS are allowed. This is to protect the image of our sport in the event press or VIPs were to be present during the weigh-in, it will put our sport in an awkward position. Please use track suits or a decent dress/jeans.
- At the parade of the nations, if you were to allocate female athletes, she should also appear in a track suit and not in bikini.
- All female athletes are to be reminded that they are participating in a sporting event and not in entertainment venues like night clubs, therefore, we should ask the women to change their behaviour when they come on to the stage in the "walk-in" wiggling their rear ends or looking back into the audience when they stand in the quarter turn facing the back of the stage and stretching out their butt and winking at the judges and the audience. This is not a sport presentation and it will be seen as sexual harassment to the public.













NATIONAL ANTHEM/NATIONAL FLAG

- a. You must provide Two(2) National Flags of your country. The flags must be manufactured of dense silk and must measure no more than 2.5 meters x 1.5 meters.
- You must also provide your National Anthem (shortened version) on CD.
 Video or cassette not acceptable.

POSING MUSIC

Posing music must be on CD and produced with good quality. The music should be cued from the start of the CD. Each competitor must affix his/her name on the CD for easy identification.

The USE OF PROFANE, VULGAR OR OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE IN POSING MUSIC IS PROHIBITED.

FAILURE TO HONOUR FINAL ENTRY FORM DEADLINE.

Deadlines are set to assist the Organizer with arranging accommodations, meal, onsite transportation and other Championships activities. A failure to respect these deadlines is a breach of the ABBF rules. If a National Federation fails to respect the deadline written on the Final Entry Form, each "Official Participant" from that federation will be required to pay all of his or her own expenses, including accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the Pre-judging, Finals and Farewell Banquet.

MEDICAL WITHDRAWAL

Once officially registered, no Athlete may withdraw from competition, without the prior approval of the ABBF Judges Chairman, who has the right to verify the reason for the withdrawal. Any National Federation that fails to seek the prior approval of the ABBF Judges Chairman before withdrawing an athlete shall be fine an amount equal to the Special Package Rate.

ATTENDANCE AT THE ABBF CONGRESS

All National Federations officially participating in the Championships must attend the Congress meeting, including National Federations with athletes and no delegates. In this case, the athlete must attend and represent his country at the congress.

ATHLETES WITHOUT DELEGATES

All athletes competing at ABBF Championships must be members in good standing of their National Federations. Any athlete who arrives without a delegate must carry an official letter of Authorization of Participation from his/her National Federation, failing which the athletes will not be eligible to participate.

MISREPRESENTATION

Misrepresentation is a serious breach of the ABBF Code of Ethics and occurs when an "Official" of a National Federation deliberately misrepresents the number of Athletes and Delegates so as to obtain free-of-charge accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the prejudging. Finals and farewell Banquet, and other amenities at the expense of the organizer. Part of this misrepresentation may be a false claim that a person is an Athlete only to have that so-called athlete fail to officially register as a competitor at the Weigh-In or, once having officially.













VISA

Please take a note that the Indian Body Builders Fedration will not be providing landed visa, hence consult the Indian Embassy in your country to determine if you need a visa. Upon request an official invitation letter shall be signed and issued by the IBBF. It is to be noted that the Visa Administration process differs from country to country and hence kindly apply well in advance. If you need any help for visa administration, please send the scanned copy of your passport to ABBF and IBBF and please ensure that is valid more than 6 months.

Last minute request will not be entertained by the IBBF.

(Courier charges for the official IBBF Invitation letter will be levied upon the invitee country and at the time of registration will be charged with the registration fees)

LANGUAGE

Official language in India is Hindi. English, Hindi and Marathi (the local language) is widely spoken in hotels, restaurants, shopping centres and tourist areas in Pune.

ELECTRICAL CURRENT

The electrical current is 220 voltage.

DOPING

Doping will be conducted by the ABBF Anti-Doping Committee in collaboration with National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), New Delhi.

The USE OF PROFANE, VULGAR OR OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE IN POSING MUSIC IS PROHIBITED.



PARTICIPATION RULES

- a. Country with less than Two (2) Competitors Only one (1) Official will be allowed to pay the official registration fee
- b. Country with Three (3) and above competitors Two (2) Officials will be allowed to pay the official registration fee
- c. Country participating with woman athletes may send One (1) extra female official and she need to pay only the official registration fee
- d. Official or any other guests requesting for a single room have to pay the differences levied by the organizer based on the supporters rates published herein.
- e. One judge per country will be allowed on gratis (No registration fee to pay) however, the judge must share a twin bed room with other judges or officials.
- f. However, country participating with woman athlete may send 1 (one) extra female judge and no need to pay the registration fee as well.
- g. If more than 2 (two) judge is nominated, he or she has to pay the registration fee, however, a country will be limited to enter two extra judges only, including one female judge to enjoy this privilege on sharing twin room. Maximum number of judges should be 3 (three) only. All other extra judges will have to pay the supporters fee in full.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

A country that exceeds the above quota will have to pay for their official and supporters fees.


